



What is the Colorado Child Care Contribution Tax Credit?

The Colorado Child Care Contribution Tax Credit promotes child care in the state of Colorado for children ages 12 and under. Donors who make contributions of cash to eligible child care organizations may claim a state and federal tax deduction and a state income tax credit of 50% of the total qualifying contribution. Most donations made to Firefly Autism are eligible for this credit, which allows donors to increase their impact and leverage larger gifts.

Which donations qualify?

Monetary donations in the form of cash or check. Donations that **do not qualify** include stocks, items or assets, grants, and gifts issued through donor-advised funds.

How could it work for me?

Example based on 35% tax bracket for individuals.	50% Credit
A. Donation	\$10,000
B. Colorado State Income Tax Savings	\$460
C. Colorado Income Tax Credit	\$5,000
D. Federal Income Tax Deduction Benefit*	\$1,590
E. Returned to you at tax time (B+C+D)	\$7,050
After tax cost of giving \$10,000 (A-E)	\$2,950
*Federal tax deduction benefit is reduced because of the add-back	
effect of reduced state taxes.

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Frequently Asked Questions

How can I make an eligible donation to Firefly Autism?

You can mail a check to Firefly Autism at 2001 Hoyt St. Lakewood, CO 80215 or give online at <u>fireflyautism.org/donate</u>.

Is there a limitation on the amount of the credit?

The credit a donor can claim for qualifying contributions made during a tax year is limited to \$100,000. If the credit exceeds the donor's tax liability, it may be carried over to the next year, for up to five additional tax years.

Is the credit allowed for gifts of appreciated assets?

No. Only monetary contributions, including qualifying charitable distributions from individual retirement accounts, are eligible.

How do I substantiate my gift for tax purposes?

Firefly Autism will provide you with Form DR 1317 at the end of the calendar for tax purposes.

Does the credit affect the amount of the charitable income tax deduction?

The IRS recently issued proposed regulations addressing the effect of state tax credits on charitable income tax deductions. Consult your tax advisor to understand how the proposed regulations may affect your individual situation.

How do I know how my donation made an impact?
