Firefly's Speech-Language Pathologist and Occupational Therapist share
their top tips and tricks to help make this your best Halloween yet!

Halloween fun can sometimes bring big sensory and communication challenges — but a little preparation can make all the difference! Our Occupational Therapists (OT) and Speech-Language Pathologists (SLP) share their favorite ways to make this spooky season a success for every child.

Sensory-Friendly Halloween Tips

1. Keep Comfort First:

Choose soft fabrics, remove tags, and consider adaptive costumes.

2. Plan sensory breaks:

Bring noise-canceling headphones or comfort items, and take quiet breaks as needed.

3. Stay safe:

Add reflective tape or glow sticks and visit well-lit, accessible areas.

4. Try alternatives:

Trunk-or-Treat or at-home trick-or-treating can be great low-sensory options.

5. Practice interactions:

Role-play “trick or treat” and “thank you” at home before heading out.

6. Use visuals:

A simple schedule helps kids know what's next and reduces anxiety.

7. Prepare communication tools:

Program Halloween phrases on AAC devices ahead of time.

8. Go early:

Trick-or-treating before dark can make it calmer and more engaging.



With a little planning, Halloween can be fun, empowering, and full of connection for everyone. Have a happy—and sensory-friendly—Halloween from all of us at Firefly Autism!
